Paris, France Exchange Program American Business School

Paris has the reputation of being the most beautiful and romantic of all cities, brimming with history while remaining vastly influential in the realms of culture, art, fashion, food and design. Much of the city, including the River Seine, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site with numerous iconic landmarks, such as the Eiffel Tower, the Arc de Triomphe, Notre-Dame Cathedral, the Louvre Museum, Luxembourg gardens, and Place de la Concorde.

Program Dates: Fall semester: August 29, 2013 to December 13, 2013
Spring semester: January 23, 2014 to May 16, 2014

Academic Program:

This exchange program is with the American Business School in Paris (www.absparis.org). FAU students can study overseas for a semester or academic year. Courses are available in Business, Humanities, and French Language. Courses are taught in English, except for the French Language courses. The American Business School Paris is IACBE (The International Assembly for Collegiate Business Education) accredited. Students must be declared College of Business majors, minors, or attaining a Business Certificate with a 2.50 overall GPA or higher and meet course pre-requisites. Students are required to attend the two day mandatory orientation sessions.

FAU Study Abroad Application fee of \$150.00 includes: Pre-departure orientation, pre-departure guidebook, and staff support.

Not Included in the Program: FAU tuition (in state/out of state rates apply), housing (assistance finding housing is provided), airfare, meals, CISI insurance (\$36 per month), visa fees (\$167), spending money and local travel.

Below is the estimated cost of living expenses/school fees per semester:

Housing: Shared Apartment (Estimate) 3400€, Textbooks (Estimate) 400€, Meals (4 months Estimate)1800€, Airport transfers on Paris Shuttle (2 @ 30€) 60€, Metro pass (Navigo pass 4 months for zone 1-2) 252€

Deadline to Apply: May 24 for fall and October 24 for spring.
